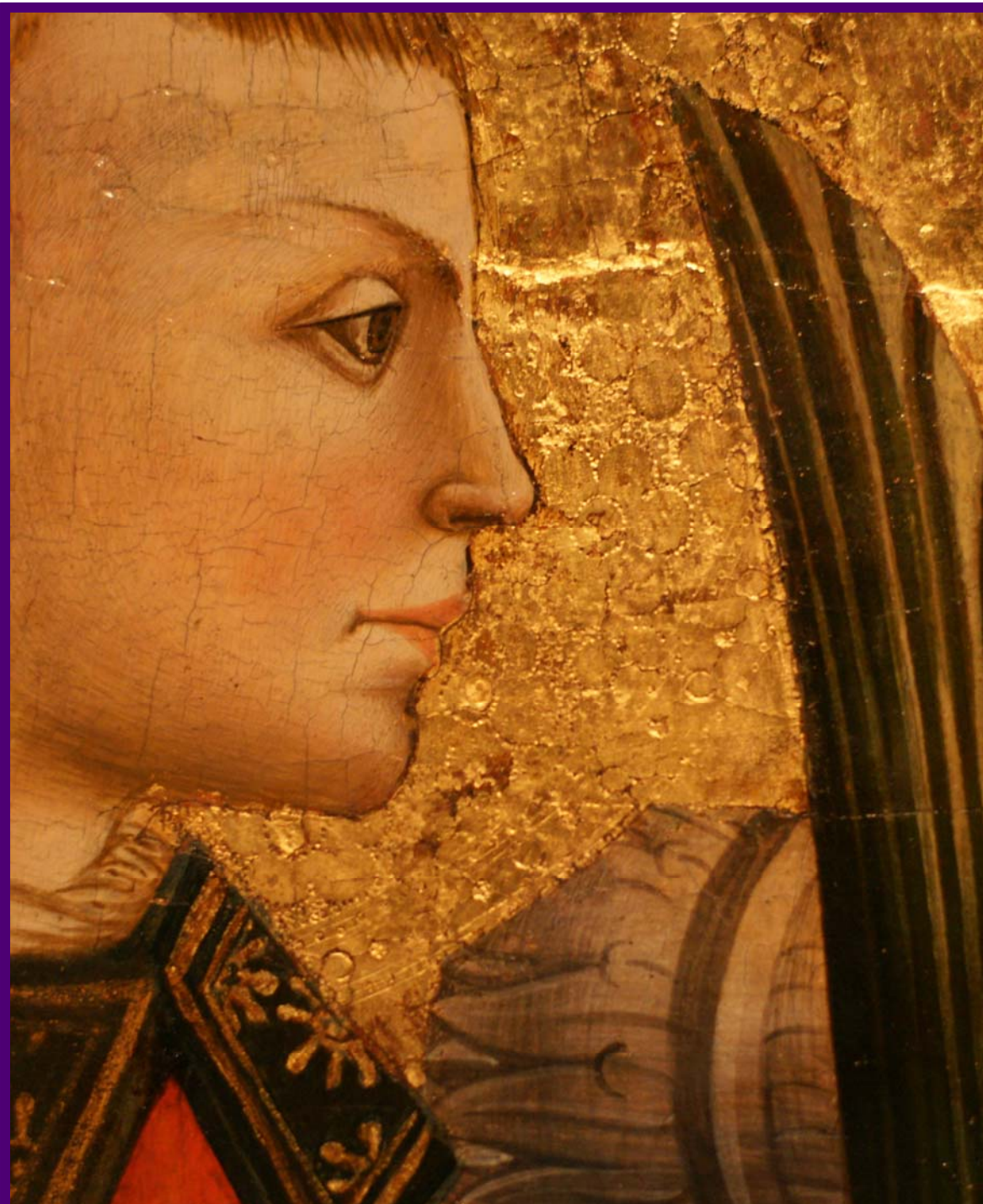


Cover: St. Lawrence with a palm. Detail of *Virgin & Child with Six Saints*.
