

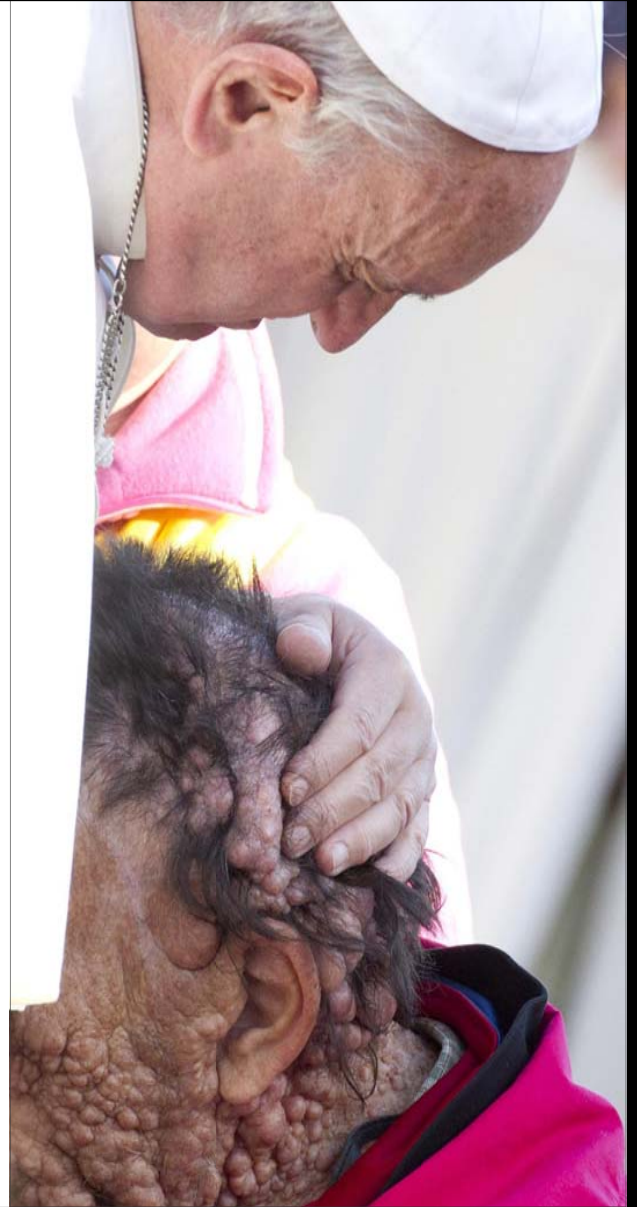
# Summoned to a Revolution of Tenderness
